Tiger Tots Pre-School Camp 2010 General Information



You and your child are sure to be delighted if you choose our Mini-Camp for Young Kids as your child's vacation destination year. If you've already done so, please do note the important points listed on this information sheet to help ensure your child's days are filled with fun!

Things to Bring ...

- Your smile
 - A labeled backpack
 - Snack for ½ day & full-day campers
 - Full-day campers should pack a home-lunch OR they can order lunch upon registration
 - Swimsuit & towel (and goggles if you wish!)
- We have water play everyday except Wednesday, and alternate between mornings and afternoons.
- A spare set of clothing
 - Diapers and wipes if necessary
 - Sunscreen (40 SPF or higher is recommended.)
 - A hat

Registration Information

Mini Camp is open to all foreign passport holders from age 2-5. You can register from April on. All children can register at the following specified times or after summer camp has begun. Tiger Tots students can register for camp April 12th & 13th. New students, who will attend TYPA Tiger Tots in the fall, can register for Summer Mini-Camp and their Fall Programs at the same time on April 27th or April 28th. Registration for TAS families begins on May 10th and Open Registration begins on May 13th. During the Summer, registration for Mini-Camp will take place in the TYPA office anytime between 9:00 A.M. – 11:30 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. – 4:00 P.M., Monday to Friday.



Mini Campers can register for one week, two or for all 6 weeks. Registration must be completed at least one week prior to the beginning of the upcoming session. For example: Registration for the second session (beginning on June 14th) must be completed by Monday, June 7th. A NT\$500 handling fee per withdrawal will be charged. If the child is going to withdraw from a camp session, the withdrawal must be made the Tuesday before their session begins in order to receive a refund.

Mini Camp begins on June 7th and ends on July 16th. Each morning/afternoon session will be three hours long. AM sessions from 9-12 are available for two, three, four, and five-year-old children. PM sessions from 12:30-3:30 are available for three, four, and five-year-old children, if a minimum number of participants has been reached. Each session costs NT\$3,600. Full-day program cost is NT\$7,200. Mini-camp will take place at the TYPA facilities on the American School Campus.

Pick up and drop off is held in the TYPA Lobby from 8:45 – 9:00, 12:00 (AM ½ day campers go home), 12:15-12:30 (PM ½ day campers arrive), and at 3:30. TYPA mini-camp staff will be present at those times to assist bringing the kids to or from class. Persons who have a TAS parking sticker may park in the TAS lot. Otherwise, parents may temporarily park in the drop off/pick up zone if they are still in the car. Vehicles are not to be left unattended in this area. Parents may also park off campus and walk their children to and from the TYPA Lobby. *Please fill out the Pick-Up Authorization form if someone other than a parent will pick up your child.

For those students who are new to Tiger Tots program, please fill out a TYPA Master Registration Form (www.typanet.org.tw) and bring a copy of the child's passport and a 1" photo when you come in for registration.
