MEMBERSHIP

In order to participate in TYPA classes, one must first be a member of TYPA. TYPA welcomes everyone from the international community and has members from all around the world. Joining TYPA is a simple process. Just come to the TYPA office with the completed master registration form (please see the website) and bring the new member's foreign passport. Non-TAS parents are required to bring in one photo each for their gate pass. Due to Taiwan government regulations governing the charter of TYPA, all members must be foreign nationals holding a foreign passport.

Each participant pays a registration fee of \$1,400 per semester. The Fall semester 2018 registration fee is for the period from **June 4 to December 21**. The Spring semester 2019 registration fee is for the period from **January 8 to May 24**.

REGISTRATION

TYPA has two main registration periods; registration for Fall programs takes place in late April/early May, and registration for Spring programs in November/early December. We have a special early registration period in March for summer activities. For specific dates, please ensure you are on our weekly email list and refer to our website. Please remember that full payment must accompany registration.

Re-Registration

During the April/May Fall registration, continuing students in progressive skill programs from Spring semester will receive priority (Advanced Registration Notice) to re-register for those classes.

During the November/December Spring registration, continuing students in all programs from Fall semester will receive priority to re-register for their classes and spaces are guaranteed. Payment can also be made through "MY TYPA" online.

Open Registration

Open Registration is for current members who wish to register for additional activities and new members who are enrolling for the first time in TYPA.

E-REGISTRATION SERVICE

TYPA provides an e-registration service for continuing students who wish to re-register for the same classes with a pre-authorized credit card and avoid another visit to the TYPA office. For the first-time user, parents need to first come to the TYPA office with a completed authorization of credit card payment form (downloaded from our website) before the registration period.

WAITING LIST

Members may be put on the waiting list when a class is fully booked. When a currently enrolled member withdraws and their space becomes available, the registrar will inform you immediately. According to the withdrawal policy, this usually happens during the first two weeks of the semester. The waiting list will be voided when the semester ends.

TAS KINDERGARTEN PICK UP SERVICE

TYPA can pick up TAS Kindergarten students and bring them to their 2:45 group class. We can also bring them to their bus or to the TYPA lobby after class. If this is an option you are interested in, please come to the office and fill out a service slip.

E-MAIL & COMMUNICATIONS

TYPA sends out weekly email news announcing events, class changes, sports schedules and upcoming registration dates. If you wish to be on our mailing list, please simply click the "Join Mailing List" button on the bottom of our website. TYPA will not sell or give your email address to other members or third parties. Mail is sent using Constant Contact® with the recipient list hidden.

FACILITIES USAGE

All participants are reminded that we use TAS facilities for our programs. There will be times in the year when classes may be cancelled or tem-

porarily moved to other locations on campus. It should be noted that TAS curricular programs take priority over TYPA recreational activities. Members are asked to please take this into consideration when signing up for TYPA activities.

CLASS CHANGES

Due to the possibility of unforeseen circumstances, such as room availability or teacher illness, TYPA reserves the right to add, cancel or change classes.

When classes are cancelled due to bad weather or other unforeseen circumstances, refunds, credits or make ups will not be given. However, in the case of tennis, music, and summer programs please refer to these specific policies on pages 17, 37, & 80 respectively. In case of a typhoon alert, check our website, or call TYPA to verify if your class has been cancelled or not.

If TYPA cancels a class, credit will be given. If a student simply misses a class, there will be no make up or refund.

CREDIT & REFUND POLICY

Withdrawal will only take effect after the member has presented TYPA with the appropriate withdrawal form which can be downloaded from our website.

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If withdrawal is completed before the due dates listed above, a \$500 processing fee will be deducted from the remaining program cost and the remainder will be refunded or credited. For summer programs, please refer to page 80.

Credits are transferable to any other class or program for a period of one year from the time of the withdrawal. The transferred credits can also be used by any member of the same family.

Refunds will be issued by check within three weeks of withdrawal notice. For amounts of less than \$3,000 a cash refund can be requested. All payments made by credit card can only be refunded to the card itself.

If the member relocates, a refund will only be issued if the withdrawal is before October 13, 2018 for the Fall semester or March 16, 2019 for the Spring semester.

LONG-TERM ILLNESS OR INJURY

Participants will only be entitled to a credit or refund for long term illness or injury if they withdraw from the activity or class for the rest of the

semester. This will be on a prorated basis and the TYPA Registrar must be informed as soon as possible of the illness or injury.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

TYPA carries liability insurance for all participants on the TAS and Tiger Tots Place campuses where TYPA activities are held, but does not carry personal medical and accident insurance which is deemed to be a personal family responsibility. Reasonably priced, on-island (Taiwan) accident insurance is available through the TYPA insurance company for TYPA members. Information about the insurance is available at the TYPA office.

FINANCIAL AID

TYPA will never turn a child away from participating in its programs due to an inability to pay for a program or a membership. Partial sponsorships are available based on individual need. Sponsorships are made possible by contributions from corporations and individual donors.

SPORTS

GENERAL INFORMATION

TYPA provides basketball, soccer and baseball leagues for lower school students. Emphasis is placed on participation, learning and fun through sports. For these sports, each student will be able to partake in one weekly practice session (see below for days and times) and Saturday games. Students will be split into teams and will compete against other students of the same age. Players of all abilities are welcome to join in the excitement of our sports programs.

- ◆ *In order for teams to be evenly matched within the league, grades 2–5 players must be present on skill assessment days. Players are rated by clinic coaches at that time. **You will not be placed on a team if you do not attend.***
- ◆ *Practices and games may be cancelled due to bad weather or poor air quality. If two or more Saturdays are cancelled due to poor conditions, we will endeavor to schedule doubleheaders to make up the games.*

TENNIS

Tennis students will need to purchase their own tennis rackets to be used for tennis lessons. Tennis or sports shoes must be worn to avoid injuries and students will also need to wear proper sportswear in class.

Tennis Lessons Grades: 1-12

Come join TYPA tennis and learn how to serve, volley and hit a ground stroke! It's a great opportunity for you to learn various tennis techniques with our outstanding tennis coaches.

The TYPA tennis program comprises **FOUR DIFFERENT TENNIS LESSONS OPTIONS:**

1. TENNIS CLINIC - Three coaches collectively instruct 15-20 students of all levels.

Tennis clinic lessons are only offered from 2:45-3:40pm (Mon-Fri). We also offer a special tennis clinic lesson on Friday 3:45-4:40pm for grade 6 and older students. At the beginning of each semester students will be assigned into different groups based on their assessed level and age. Tennis students will not be able to choose their own instructor. **To be fair, each student may only enroll in two tennis clinic classes per week.**

2. PRIVATE - One on one

3. SEMI-PRIVATE - One coach with 2-3 students

4. GROUP - One coach with 4-6 students

All Private, Semi-private and Group lessons are scheduled between 3:45-7:15pm on weekdays, and on Saturdays from 7:00am - 7:00pm.

All tennis lessons are scheduled in the following manner:

Towards the end of each semester, re-registration for continuing students takes place.

During open registration, any available spaces remaining are offered on

a first-come, first-served basis. If a desired coach or time is unavailable, names are placed on a waiting list. All waiting lists and special requests are purged at the end of each semester.

Partnering up

If you sign up for a semi-private lesson, please endeavor to find a partner for yourself beforehand. If you cannot find a partner, please sign up for a private lesson initially and TYPA will try to help you find a partner at your level and age.

If you sign up for a semi-private or group lesson, but your partner(s) decide to cancel or reschedule to another time slot, your tuition will be adjusted according to the number of students registered for that class.

Tennis Courts Usage

Please note that TYPA tennis lessons will be held on the TAS Rubber D area.

The tennis lessons from 3:50-5:20pm on Mondays will be held at the Taipei Japanese School (across from TAS). TYPA will walk younger children over to the TJS campus if parents wish.

There will be times during the year when tennis lessons may be cancelled due to conflicts with TAS activities. Members should note that TAS's curricular programs take priority over TYPA recreational activities. Please take this into consideration when signing up for TYPA tennis programs.

Tennis Waiting List

When TYPA tennis lessons are full, members can fill out a tennis waiting list form and submit it to the TYPA office. If any spot becomes available, the next member on the waiting list will be contacted. According to the withdrawal policy, this usually happens during the first two weeks of the semester. The waiting lists expire at the end of the semester.

Cancellation Policy

After the second week of the semester, no credits or refunds will be given due to withdrawals and no schedule changes will be allowed. There will be no credits or refunds for missed tennis clinics, group lessons and semi-private lessons. Private lessons are allowed one cancellation per semester but the cancellation must be done at least 24 hours in advance. Please note, canceled tennis lessons will not be made up.

Regarding injury cancellation, we will only issue a refund to an injured student if they withdraw for the rest of the semester. Please provide a medical certificate when applying for an injury refund. Once the injury application has been submitted, the student will lose priority registration for the re-registration period.

DANCE

GENERAL INFORMATION

First semester dance classes concentrate on fundamentals, techniques, flexibility, and body placement. Second semester dance classes concentrate on performing skills. Students will also learn a choreographed routine to be performed in the Spring Dance Recital in May. For maximum benefit, we recommend students begin their dance studies in the fall and continue into the spring.

♦ *All of the dance classes (except Baby Ballet) will perform on stage for the Spring Dance Show. Please be aware that there will be additional costs for costumes.*

Dress Code Policy

The TYPA Dance Department has a dress code for all dance classes. It is the student's responsibility to acquire the appropriate attire necessary for individual classes.

TYPA does not sell or otherwise provide uniforms. Students are required to purchase their own uniforms from a local retailer or with assistance from the dance instructor. Families please contact your dance instructor for further assistance if needed.



BALLET

Dancers need to wear a leotard, ballet tights, ballet shoes and have their hair up.

Baby Ballet

Age: 3

In this dance class, three-year olds will be taught how to dance through creative movements. They will develop an appreciation of rhythm and timing, music and grace. This program also will help develop your child's body coordination.

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



GENERAL INFORMATION

TYPA offers martial arts classes in four distinct disciplines – Aikido, Karate, Ninja and Taekwon-Do. Martial arts teaches respect, courtesy, and self-discipline as well as improving flexibility, strength, stamina, health and fitness.

Discipline, attitude and respect for martial arts will be emphasized. Examples of the above guidelines include promptness to class, proper wearing of uniforms and respect for the martial arts master and fellow students.

All TYPA martial arts classes are minimal body contact. Older beginning students or students with experience in a different martial arts discipline may attend higher-level classes at the discretion of the instructor.

Belt Advancement Tests

Testing criteria will not only include skills, but discipline, attitude and respect displayed

throughout the semester. Students will not advance to the next belt level unless all these criteria are met to the satisfaction of the instructor. It is not mandatory to take the test, however, it is recommended to try if your child would like to advance to the next level. *Please note there will be an additional cost for tests.* Parents are encouraged to watch the test take place.

Dress Code Policy for Martial Arts

TYPA does not sell or otherwise provide uniforms. Students are required to purchase their own uniforms from a local retailer or with assistance from the instructor. Students must be in a properly-fitted uniform by the third lesson or they are subject to sitting out that class. Each discipline has its own unique uniform and different color schedule for its belt system.

AIKIDO

Aikido in its present form was developed in Japan in the early 20th century. Aikido is seen not only as a system of self-defense, but also as a means of self-cultivation and improvement. It is unique among martial arts in that the majority of techniques are based on aggressors making the first move and using their energy and momentum to neutralize them.



Aikido

Grades: 1-Adult

On a physical level, Aikido involves some throws and joint locks. It focuses not in punching or kicking, but rather on using the opponent's energy to gain control and throw him away from you. An excellent class for a parent/child duo to enjoy.





ABOUT THE TIGER TOTS PROGRAM

At Tiger Tots, we provide a safe, nurturing learning environment for children from the ages of 18 months to 6 years. Our programs have been designed to follow North American standards, and we provide age-appropriate educational goals, values, and philosophies which are implemented within a challenging and exciting learning environment. Play sets the stage for learning and provides the medium through which the children may imitate, explore, test ideas, acquire information, and draw conclusions. Our experienced, caring personnel emphasize and foster a positive self-image while encouraging uniqueness within socialization. The unique interests of each child are used as a guide for inquiries and exploration within the classroom. Tiger Tots also offers weekly gymnastics, music, and Kidsportz (4s and 5s) by TYPA specialized instructors. In addition, Mandarin classes are available for those students who want to acquire a new language or improve their first language.

COMMUNITY OF LEARNERS

All of our teachers are qualified educators, many of whom have been with Tiger Tots for several years. They work as a team to develop and implement meaningful and engaging programs for children, based on emergent curriculum planning techniques. Our teachers and teaching assistants are dedicated to participation in ongoing professional development and are also committed to, and encourage, active parent involvement and communication. Together, our love for children and the quality of education we offer creates a wonderful community of learners.

REGISTRATION

Prospective families should fill out a waiting list application form which can be downloaded off the TYPA web site or picked up at the front desk at either campus. There is no fee for waiting list placement. Upon completion of the form, new families may be contacted for a required visitation before registration.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$15,000 per semester is required for each child upon his/her acceptance into the program.

Tuition for Fall semester must be paid in full by June 29. Tuition for Spring semester must be paid in full upon registration in November. **No refunds or credits will be given (toward TYPA or Tiger Tots programs) after tuition due dates unless families are leaving Taiwan.** If tuition is not paid by the due date, it will be assumed the child will not attend. If parents choose to take a vacation during scheduled school days, tuition will not be refunded or credited for the child's time away from preschool.

All Tiger Tots class fees cover one full semester. Classes are available once a minimum number of participants has been reached.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

A minimum of two weeks written notice is required for withdrawal from all Tiger Tots programs. Please inquire at the TYPA office for a withdrawal form or download one from the TYPA web site. Families who must leave

Tiger Tots because of relocation to another country may receive a tuition refund for the amount of the semester not used. If the family relocates, a refund will only be issued if the withdrawal is before **October 12, 2018** for the fall semester or **March 15, 2019** for the spring semester. The registration fee is non-refundable.

LUNCH

A hot lunch is available for full-day children. Tiger Tots Place provides fresh fruit and orders lunches from local vendors who have proven to demonstrate hygienic food preparation and provide healthy lunch choices. We order lunches from Taipei American School food services for Pre-K and K children. Lunch orders are placed in advance per semester. Parents can choose to send in a home lunch or a mixture of both choices for their child as well.

DROP OFF & PICK UP

At both campuses, children may **be dropped off between 8:30am and 9:00am**. If you are driving, please be sure to allow our staff to safely transport your child from the car into school. We respectfully ask that children arrive to school on time and are picked up promptly at the end of class time.

The Three-Year-Old Program is designed to encourage a balance of child-initiated and teacher-facilitated activities. This program offers children a variety of choices provided within a carefully prepared indoor and outdoor environment. Two-Year-Old Playgroups meet either two, three or five days each week, depending on the schedule you choose at registration. There is also the option of the full-day two-year-old program which includes nap time, free choice time, and story time. The full-day program allows an easy adjustment for the child needing to remain with his/her teacher and in his/her classroom until the end of the school day. Our two-year-old class-

rooms are located at Tiger Tots Campus.

The Two-Year-Old Program encourages the growth of independence and social awareness, sensory exploration, the development of physical skills, and language development. Children play in planned indoor and outdoor environments designed to provide a variety of materials to explore.

For two-year-olds, it can take some time for the child to be totally comfortable in the group environment, to seek out teachers for support and to develop increased peer social skills. To ease this transition at the beginning of each semester, a parent or other consistent caregiver may remain in the classroom with the child until the teaching staff indicates that a separation from this primary adult is appropriate and can be comfortably accomplished.
