Dear Tiger Tots Parents

We recently received the following information from TAS:

The School health and safety program begins at home therefore we ask that you please monitor your children and check their body temperature before sending them to school.

As is the case presently, everyone entering the campus will have their temperatures checked. Should you be denied entry, you need to be symptom free for 24 hours before returning.

Hand sanitizing is required of everyone.

Masks are required to be worn.

Visitors to the campus must provide their name and contact information and sign an affirmation that they have not traveled internationally or been in contact with someone who has traveled globally in the last 14 days.

If a student, staff member or third-party visitor should meet someone who is still in their 14-day quarantine period, **they may not come on campus** until the person with whom the contact was made has completed their 14 days of quarantine without illness or symptoms of illness.

Effective new measures from January 11th – 22nd 2021.

TAS Campus will be closed to all parents and other third-party visitors unless that person has been invited to attend a meeting or event. This is a temporary restriction due to the possible off-island travel of some TAS families and staff. A campus assess update will be provided on **January 22nd**, **2021**. Parents, please note that it is your responsibility to inform the school should a returning family member quarantine in the home, the student will remain at home until this period has ended.

To avoid confusion, the school's policy is different from the advice travelers will receive at the airport and on the CECC website. IOW, a student MAY NOT come to school if another person is completing their quarantine in the same house as the child.
