TYPA will process the 2023 Fall registration online, all members are required to submit forms listed in each section below in order for their registration to be processed. Please note that full payment will be charged upon registration.

RE-REGISTRATION for Continuing Students in progressive skill programs

Log in to "MY TYPA" online to submit your "FALL BILL" May 1 – May 5

Re-Registration is only for continuing students in progressive skill programs. These programs include Dance, Gymnastics, Music, Martial Arts, Lego, Tennis, Mandarin, Chess, Actor's Workshop, Young Inventors Club, and Code Wizards.

The assigned class day, time, and level for the Fall semester can be found in the "FALL BILL" section online. **Members must log in to "MY TYPA"** to confirm the activities they wish to continue for the Fall and confirm the payment method.

If continuing students do not complete the "FALL BILL" process by May 5, their spots will become available to other students.

The "Available Activities" page online will only be accurate after May 8. This form should be submitted to info@typa.org.tw between May 8 and May 12. After that, members must get a Q-up Number from "My TYPA" online between 10:00-13:00 on May 15 for Tiger & TAS families and May 22 for all other members. The registration will then be processed according to the received Q-up Number. The payment for successfully registered activities will be processed by charging your *pre-authorized* credit card.

Open registration is for returning members who want to register for additional activities other than the "FALL BILL" classes *and* for new members who are enrolling for the first time at TYPA. Members at this time may also register for our basketball and soccer season.

* You are a TAS or Tiger Tots Family if at least one of your children will attend TAS or Tiger Tots (excluding Enrichment Programs) in the 2023 Fall semester.
